**ELECTRIC SERVICE
SCHEDULE SL**

Street Lighting

AVAILABILITY: At any point on Association's interconnected system. This rate not for resale.

APPLICATION: This schedule is for service required for the lighting of public streets, thoroughfares, alleys and public grounds by mercury vapor lamps and sodium vapor lamps, where service is supplied at approximately 120/240 volts, single-phase at a single point of delivery from existing secondary.

SERVICE SPECIFICATIONS:

Association-Owned System: Service includes energy, maintenance, lamp and glassware replacements. Lamps will be controlled to operate from dusk to dawn. Any damage resulting from vandalism shall be charged to the Consumer at cost of repair.

Consumer-Owned System: All standards, brackets, foundations, lighting units and glassware shall be at the expense of the city or property owner. Maintenance, lamp and glass renewals shall be negotiated with the Association.

UNDERGROUND OPTION: The Consumer may elect underground service to a street light location by providing a trench (24" deep), bedding and backfill. Underground construction shall be limited to 100 ft. at Association expense. Beyond that limit the Consumer will pay all construction costs.

TERMS OF PAYMENT: Payment is due within twenty (20) days after the bill is prepared.

SPECIAL PROVISION: Rates and Service hereunder subject to Electric Service Regulations of the Association as amended from time to time.

EFFECTIVE: July 1, 2000
